



How the Waitlist Works

The Vancouver Society of Children's Centres (VSOCC) operates nearly 800 licensed child care spaces for children ages 3 months to 12 years old.

While our goal is to provide child care for as many families as possible, our wait list does **NOT operate** on a "first come, first serve basis" **We give priority to current VSOCC families and families who live in neighbourhoods around our Centres.** (* see map on page 4)

PROCEDURE

When a space becomes available, we offer it first to eligible VSOCC children (Group A) and then to families in Group B. If the space is not accepted, we contact those who are on the general waitlist (Group C).

GROUP A: CHILDREN WHO ARE CURRENTLY ATTENDING A VSOCC program

Using the child's **start date** we offer spaces in the following order:

1. Children currently enrolled in the same Centre
2. Siblings currently enrolled in a different VSOCC Centre
3. Children currently enrolled who wish to transfer to a different VSOCC Centre are eligible to transfer after a **minimum** of 12 months from the start date.

GROUP B: CHILDREN WHO PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED VSOCC but had to leave VSOCC because of a lack of available space in the next age group program.

GROUP C: GENERAL

Using the child's **application date** we offer spaces in the following order:

1. Children who have a sibling enrolled at VSOCC
2. Children of VSOCC employees
3. Children who live in the neighbourhood** where the centre is located (or for school age programs, in the defined catchment area for that elementary school)
4. Children who live in other VSOCC neighbourhoods; or
5. Children who live outside of VSOCC neighbourhoods.

Other Considerations:

- If there are 2 or more children who have the same **start or waitlist** date, the oldest child will be offered the space first.
- VSOCC will only offer child care services to children who will be enrolled for at least 4 months.
- To be eligible for School Age programs, children must be enrolled in Elsie Roy Elementary School or Crosstown Elementary School. Priority is given to children who are currently enrolled who have a sibling enrolled in the school age location where the space is vacant.
- Under 3 programs maintain a balance of infant and toddler age children which may impact the priority in which spaces are offered.


